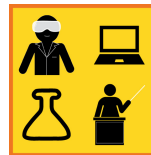

Career Development Committee



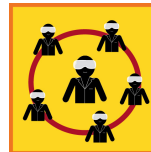
Organize workshops, networking events, & seminars focused on careers & soft skills.

Social Committee



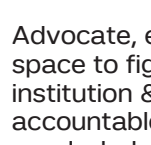
Organize mixers & annual events like bowling night, BBQs, Holiday Parties & more.
